For Holy Saturday (Easter Vigil) in 2025, there are nine readings assigned: seven from the Old Testament and two from the New Testament. If necessary, the number of readings can be reduced. Three readings from the Old Testament should be read before the Epistle and Gospel. One reading that must always be included is Exodus 14:15-15:1 about the Israelites' escape through the Red Sea. The specific readings for Holy Saturday are: 1. Genesis 1:1-2:2 or Genesis 1:1, 26-31a with Psalm 104 or Psalm 33 2. Genesis 22:1-18 or Genesis 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18 with Psalm 16 3. Exodus 14:15-15:1 and Exodus 15:1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 17-18 (always included) 4. Isaiah 54:5-14 with Psalm 30 5. Isaiah 55:1-11 with Isaiah 12:2-3, 4, 5-6 6. Baruch 3:9-15, 32-4:4 with Psalm 19 (John 6:68c) 7. Ezekiel 36:16-17a, 18-28 with Psalms 42 and 43 (or Isaiah 12:2-3, 4bcd, 5-6 or Psalm 51 if a baptism is celebrated) The two New Testament readings are: 8. Romans 6:3-11 with Psalm 118 ****Misa de Gallo Guide**** The Misa de Gallo is a special Mass that guides us in our preparation for Christmas. "Umanhi Ka" 2. "O Come, Divine Messiah" ****Readings**** * Micah 5:1-4A: God promises a ruler from Bethlehem * Psalm 80: Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved * Hebrews 10:5-10: Christ's arrival meant replacing old sacrifices with his own body * Luke 1:39-45: Mary visits Elizabeth, whose baby leaped for joy upon hearing Mary ****Offertory Songs**** Choose from the following songs: 1. "Aniang Among Halad" 2. "Daygon Ikaw Ginoong Dios" ****Communion Songs**** Choose from the following songs: 1. "Andama ang Dalan" 2. "Liwanag ng aming Puso" ****Recessional Songs**** Choose from the following songs: 1. "E1" (if not used in Entrance) 2.
