The Straw Hat Pirates ventured into the wilderness of Crown Island where they encountered intelligent animals, but it was Chopper who triggered a prophecy and became the island's lord and protector as the King of Beasts. Despite some interesting fight scenes, Chopper's Kingdom is a skippable filler film that can be watched after episode 102 of the Arabasta Arc in the One Piece saga. Another adventure follows when the Straw Hat Pirates participate in an underground pirate race called the Dead End Competition due to needing cash, and they find themselves competing against a powerful vice-admiral and his bounty hunter sidekick. This film is a fantastic adventure that can be enjoyed by both newbies and die-hards and should be watched after episode 130, but it fits best in line with episode 138 in the Goat Island arc of the Sky Island Saga. The Cursed Holy Sword revolves around Zoro and takes place on Asuka Island where the Straw Hat Pirates learn about a legendary cursed sword. However, this film is a chaotic mess that doesn't come together well and can be skipped unless you're interested in knowing more about Zoro's character, and it falls best after episode 143 of the Ruluka Island arc in the Sky Island Saga. Baron Omatsuri and the Secret Island sees the Straw Hat Pirates stopping at a recreation island to relax but soon find themselves unraveling a mystery beneath its seemingly happy surface. Without giving away too much, this film is worth watching and should be viewed after episode 224 of the Ocean's Dream arc in the Water 7 Saga. The Giant Mechanical Soldier of Karakuri Castle offers great action sequences and an offbeat plotline when the Straw Hats help an old lady return home from Mecha Island in exchange for a treasure. This film is best seen after episode 228 of the Foxy's Return arc in the Water 7 Saga. Lastly, most One Piece fans will agree that the Arabasta Arc is one of the best, making this condensed version movie extremely skippable if you've already watched those episodes. If you're looking for new storylines in One Piece, consider watching specific movies as supplementary content after reaching certain episodes. The Arabasta remake after episode 312 is a good option if you need a refresher with high-quality action sequences. Alternatively, watch the Chopper Plus remake after episode 325 for an alternate universe storyline where Luffy and his crew face different challenges. For another exciting adventure, watch One Piece Film: Strong World after episode 381. This movie explores Shiki's devil fruit powers as he tries to destroy the Marines, leading to a thrilling battle between Luffy and his crew. While not canon, Strong World offers an engaging experience that can be enjoyed at any time after episode 381. However, watching it after the last episode (429) of Little East Blue arc of the Summit Saga provides better alignment with the overall storyline. One Piece 3D: Straw Hat Chase is considered a short and somewhat lost media, but it's skippable even for hardcore completionists. You can watch it directly after finishing Strong World. One Pieces movies, featuring a story centered around former marine admiral Z and his attempt to steal the "Dyna Stones." This movie is highly recommended, but you can choose when to watch it - either after episode 573 or at the end of the Z's Ambition arc with episode 578. Lastly, visit the entertainment city on the Gran Tesoro ship by watching One Piece Film: Gold after finishing the Silver Mine arc of the Whole Cake Island Saga. This casino-themed adventure offers slick animation and plenty of action from start to finish, making it a satisfying experience for fans who have followed the series this far. One Piece fans have a lot to be excited about with new movies and adaptations on the horizon. For those looking to catch up or revisit the series, here's a brief guide on how to watch One Piece movies in release order. First off, some recommendations for watching specific movies. The recent releases include One Piece: Stampede (watch after episode 889) and One Piece Film: Red (watch after episode 1030). Both are high-energy adventures filled with fan favorite characters and epic battles. For a more comprehensive list of One Piece movies, check out the provided sequence in release order.
